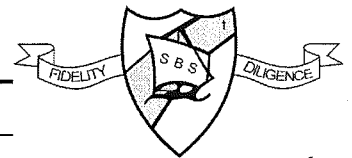

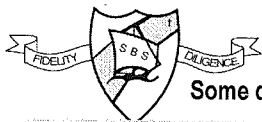

ST BRENDAN'S SCHOOL 2012 ANNUAL PAYMENTS

Cash / Cheque / Online Payments Accepted (Eftpos unavailable)

Some donations / fees will be apportioned when child/ren start at St Brendan's School during the school year.

DONATIONS

School Donation & Photocopying amounts are voluntary donations that allow the school to offer all students a wider range of activities and experiences than those funded by Government grants. The RE Resource is a necessary component of the Religious Educational Curriculum.

School Donation - \$100 per child or \$200 per family

This annual donation helps to boost the limited funds available for spending on school-wide programmes, classroom materials, activities, teaching or curriculum resourcing, and dramatically enhances our ability to maintain and improve these important resources. The suggested donation per child of \$100 amounts to approximately 50c per school day. Payment of this donation can be made in a lump sum or by automatic payments (minimum \$5.00 per week). A form is attached for this purpose for completion and return to the school office. Donations are tax deductible and receipts will be issued for automatic payments made during the financial year April – March annually in June and sent home with your son/daughter. We would appreciate the remaining fees and donation paid to the school office by the end of the first term to allow us to provide the necessary resources required.

Photocopy Donation- \$25.00 per child

Funds received from the Photocopy donation help towards meeting the extensive photocopying requirements for students and covers such items as School and Syndicate Newsletters, Notices, formal letters, student worksheets and other student requirements (other than school text books) etc.

RE Resource Donation - \$12.00

The Religious Education curriculum was updated by NCRS in 2011 and it is a requirement each child participates in the programme. This cost covers access to the software resource which is an essential component to implementing this programme as part of the Special Character of St Brendan's School.

FEES

Camp 2012 - \$320 per child (*raw cost*)

The bi-annual Camp 2012 will be held at Tea Pot Valley, Nelson. In the past we have been able to reduce the **raw cost** of camp due to fundraising and a trust application. The cost includes return ferry trip, full accommodation, all meals, events, programmes and bus hireage. Details and updates will continue to be sent home under separate cover until departure date. Payment is required before 29/2/12. Please see your classroom teacher if you have any concerns regarding camp or payment.

Events - \$65.00 per child

The purpose of this fee is for teachers to plan and budget for upcoming performances, class trips, educational activities and special events that the whole class will participate in.

Swimming - \$45.00 per child

The swimming fee is to pay for entrance to local swimming pools. – (*if any excess remains upon completion of the swimming programme this will go into supplementing the Events Fee*).

We ask for these fees up front to make it easier for parents to make a one off payment for events at the beginning of the year so that apart from special sporting or team activities e.g. Flippaball, there will be no other requests for payments throughout the year for class events.

Technicraft – (For Senior Syndicate School Rm's 4 & 6 only) \$70.00 for Year 7 & 8 Students

The purpose of this fee is for attendance at Fergusson Intermediate, for Year 7 & 8 students, for instruction in the area of food technology, textiles, IT/materials technology, and visual arts. Payment of one term or more will allow your child to attend this weekly class. Please note it is a curriculum requirement that your child participate and attends. Children depart by bus each Wednesday afternoon during term time.

Civil Defence 2012

A suggested Civil Defence pack (per student) should preferably be in an A3 sized sealable plastic bag, take into account any food allergies or special dietary requirements and contain:

Child's name & room number viewable through plastic sealable bag, 2x 1.5ltr Water, 2 small tinned meals, 2 small tins of fruit, 2 snack items, 6-10 (wrapped) barley sugar lollies, 2 large plastic bags, 1 plastic spoon.

Please provide the packs to the classroom teacher on day one ready for the 2012 year, or if a new student on the day he/she Starts at St Brendan's School. Packs will be returned to parents / caregivers at the end of the year.

CSB ATTENDANCE DUES

\$386.00 incl gst per annum per primary school child from 2012 (\$96.50 per term), collected by the Catholic Schools Board

These funds are used by the Catholic Schools Board for the upkeep and further development of the Catholic School System in New Zealand. When St Brendan's School was rebuilt several years ago, and more recently the addition of the Administration building, it was mostly funded by the school fees of parents throughout the Catholic Community.
